Firstly and most importantly, I hope you are well.

I am writing to inform you of arrangements for the collection of your A Level/BTEC results on Thursday 13 August. Understandably, there is a lot of anticipation for this event and we look forward to seeing you again after the lengthy lockdown. Obviously, the collection of Year 13 results is time sensitive and we are acutely aware that you will want to get them as soon as possible. **Results are available from 8am until 11 am.** Unlike previous years however, due to current Covid situation, we will look to operate the collection of results slightly differently which will enable social distancing and adhere to government guidance but allow you to obtain them as swiftly as possible.

In order to collect results and to adhere to social distancing, this will take place in Dining Room. You will be directed to a specific area to collect your results. **Regrettably, and as I am sure you will appreciate, to reduce the numbers on site, parents/carers are unable to accompany you on site to collect your results.**

Please find enclosed a list of FAQs that will answer any questions you may have.

If you are unable to collect your results, you are able to allow another person to collect them on your behalf, providing they bring a signed letter from you, naming you along with some photo ID. If results are left uncollected, they will be posted out that day.

In the unlikely event that you have not achieved the results you were expecting, we are opening up a Clearing hub in the Media Suite so you can get in touch with UCAS and universities to look at alternative provision. Again, this will be only open to students who have missed out on their grades.

Finally, we want to keep in touch with our students past and present. We have an Alumni group for our students to remain in contact and to receive updates about what is going on in Post 16. Many of our former students come back into college to support or current students with work experience opportunities, interview practice or careers advice.
